1. The Panchkhal Municipality invites sealed quotations from registered Suppliers for the supply and delivery of Fruit Plants
2. Eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding Documents at the office of Panchkhal Municipality.
3. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased from the office Panchkhal Municipality by eligible Bidders on the submission of a written application, along with the copy of company/firm registration certificate, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of NRs. 1000.00 till 2078/02/23 during office hours.
4. Sealed bids must be submitted to the office Of Panchkhal Municipality by hand on or before 12:00 noon on 2078/02/24. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
5. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 2078/02/24, 1:00 PM at the office of Panchkhal Municipality. Bids must be valid for a period of 4 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to a minimum of 25,000/-, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid. If bidder wishes to submit the Cash Security, the cash should be deposited in Deposit Account No. 12403000003000000001 (बचत खाता) (for bid security) at Nepal Bank Ltd., Panchkhal Branch and submit the receipt of the deposited amount of cash along with the Sealed Quotation.
6. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
7. The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject, wholly or partly any or all the Sealed Quotations without assigning any reason, whatsoever.
